Chelangat back to defend 10km title in Cape Town

Kenyan faces strong challenge

The Absa Run Your City (RYC) Cape Town 10K is fast shaping up to be the most explosive road race in SA with the announcement that Kenyan star and defending champion Jesca Chelangat will be back to defend her title.

Her addition to the elite field of athletes makes this one of the highest quality female running fields assembled on African soil for a 10km race.

Event organisers have also

confirmed SA's Tayla Kavanagh, Lesotho's national 10km record holder Neheng Khatala and last year's third-place finisher Diana Chesang of Kenya, are among the top contenders.

"We're committed to continue adding to the already impressive list of athletes that will toe the line at the seventh edition of the Absa RYC Cape Town 10K on Sunday 15 May," confirmed Michael Meyer, MD of Stillwater Sports and founder of SA's leading 10km road running series.

"To say that the women's elite race is going to be world class and nail-biting is an understatement and that is

exactly what we want. We are proud to give SA's elite runners the opportunity to face the world's best runners here on home soil."

Chelangat has raced only once this year, clocking 35:25 at the Agnes Tirop Cross Country Classic over 10km in Eldoret, Kenya, on February 12. As a result, she will be fresh. Boasting a 15:52.02 time over 5 000m (at an altitude of 1,795m in Nairobi) last year, she not only has raw speed but also endurance to back it up.

But Chelangat will not have it all her own way come race day. Ugandans Stella Chesang and Mercyline Chelangat will mount a serious challenge.

Objective and focus areas of the program

The Gauteng Provincial Government (GPG) through the Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD) and Gauteng Department of Economic Development (GDED) invite all interested parties to submit partnership proposals to form part of the Gauteng Cannabis Industrialization program. The objective of the program is to unlock economic opportunities and job creation through cultivation and processing of hemp and cannabis at an industrial scale.

Focus areas: Potential partners may submit proposals which are aligned to the industrial focal points / enablers which the Gauteng Provincial Government is already activating.

These include:

- Funding and capitalization mechanisms for Cannabis/hemp cultivation, processing and distribution.
- Exchange, trading, and aggregation platforms for domestic and export markets including certification and quality assurance: partnership proposals.
- Aggregation schemes for cultivation and processing linked to quantifiable and verifiable addressable markets for cannabis and hemp products.

These aggregation schemes must include deliberate and extensive enterprise and supplier development opportunity pathways, which include and enable surrounding communities as value chain partners.

- Cannabis-driven Carbon reduction and Bioremediation program including rehabilitation of compromised Mine Lands.

GPG support instruments that can form the basis of such partnership proposals include but are not limited to:

- Leases on state-owned or state-controlled land assets.
- Tenancy in special economic zones or state-owned industrial parks or subsidized tenancy in private industrial facilities.
- Financing partnerships to deploy wholesale capital or other appropriate instruments via Gauteng Enterprise Propeller (GEP) and/or development finance institutions that are in partnership with the province.
- Collaborative funding of key input and administrative costs of proposed partnerships.
- Structured collaboration with other organs of state to manage regulatory or other barriers to cannabis industrialization for specific projects.
